LENT

FROM its beginnings, the Church has coordinated the cycles of the calendar year with the commemoration of the events of "Salvation History": how God has interacted with humans to reveal their true nature and relationship with the Divine.

DURING the 40 days of Lent we are led through the journey or "Path" of Jesus from his temptations in the desert through his Last Supper and crucifixion to his Resurrection. We see the Human and the Divine Mystery of Death leading to greater Life, not only for Jesus; but for all of us, as we open to the deepest aspects of our true Selves. This Mysterious Miracle of Divinity in Human Form discovering and revealing itself in every moment is symbolically presented by the season of Lent to each of us. The church says, "See how God transforms humans. See how Divinity is revealed in all aspects of our lives. See how everything we experience, whether it is joy or suffering, is only an opportunity to release the illusions of judgment and separation – an opportunity to reveal our true Divine Nature. See Jesus and see yourself!"

AS Jesus said, "These things and greater shall **YOU DO!**" Lent gives us an opportunity to see who truly we are. It gives us an opportunity to see the falsity of any sense of unworthiness. Lent is **NOT** about suffering. Lent is about **HOPE**. Lent is about emptying ourselves of false pictures and images of who we are. Lent **IS ABOUT GOD'S TOTAL, UNCONDITIONAL LOVE FOR US!!**

IF there is anything that we can "give up for Lent," it is the false pictures of our being un-lovable, un-forgivable, unworthy. The opportunity of Lent is to **STOP LISTENING** to the Voices of judgment within us. **DO NOT** let yourself be distracted from the **VOICE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT** saying to you, "YOU are my Beloved in whom I AM, and have always been, well Pleased!"

REMEMBER the words of Jesus, the Christed One, "As the Father has loved Me, so do I Love YOU! Abide in My Love!" These are the words to listen to. These are the words of Lent. These are the words which will bring Healing and Anointing to the deep wounds of judgment within You. These are the words of a loving God within You. These are the words you have **LONGED TO HEAR!** These are the words of Your Father/Mother! These are the words that invite you to leave all notions of Death and enter into the Mystery of Eternal LIFE!

HAVE A HAPPY LENT!!!!!!!!!!!!!!
